Obtaining a Client ID and a Secret ID from PayPal

In order to obtain a client ID and a secret ID from PayPal, you'll first need to navigate to <u>PayPal's website</u> and log in using your PayPal account information. Once you have successfully logged in, you'll be on the home page. From there, click the dropdown arrow next to your account name in the upper right portion of the screen, pictured below.

Then click on the 'Dashboard' link. This will be the name on the account.



This is PayPal's Dashboard page. From this page you should look for a link reading 'My Apps & Credentials', which should be on the upper left on the sidebar.
